



### Air Lifting Bag Serial Numbers

The following information provides examples of serial numbers to help you and your customers determine the age of their Air Lifting Bags.

- 1025**            The top numbers (1025) indicate that the bag was the 1025<sup>th</sup> bag manufactured that year.
  
- 201989**        The second row of numbers (201989) indicates that the bag was made in the 20<sup>th</sup> week of the year 1989.
  
- 991245**        The first two digits represent the year the bag was manufactured. In this case, the bag was made in 1999. The last four digits (1245) indicate that the bag was the 1245<sup>th</sup> bag manufactured that year.  
Other examples: 910245, 932428, etc.
  
- 84321**            The serial numbers that are only five digits were produced in the 1980's (well beyond the bag's life span). The first digit of the number represents the last digit of the year it was made. The number in this example begins with 8 which means it was manufactured in 1988. The last four digits (4321) indicate that the bag was the 4321<sup>st</sup> bag manufactured in 1988.
